



PRESEASON INSPECTIONS CHECKLIST

VSI BRINE MAKER

Suggested checkpoints during a preseason inspection include:

-  Disconnect brine maker from power and clean inside of tank to remove sediment. Ensure salinity probe, batch tank, and agitation nozzle are free of buildup or debris. Inspect for loose hardware or cracked welds, reconnect to power.
-  Update VSI Spray App to the latest version. If unsure, uninstall and reinstall app.
-  Connect brine maker via Bluetooth with the VSI Spray App, then connect the brine maker to Wi-Fi and check for firmware updates. A cyan light indicates Wi-Fi connection, and a magenta light shows an auto-update is in progress.
-  Fill brine tank a quarter full with water and energize pump to pressurize the system. Check for leaks and ensure all nozzles provide proper flow.
-  Fill tank with 60°F water and make a test batch of brine. Compare the digital salinity readout to a manual hydrometer to verify the salinity probe's calibration.
